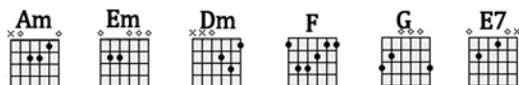


Troublemaker

INTRO: Am, Em, Dm, F, G

VERSE ONE:

Dm **F** **G**

Am **Em**

Dm **F**
Get my ass to rehab, but you'd still be gone
G
I screwed up bad this time

VERSE TWO:

Am **Em**
The siren's song was callin' me; I couldn't stay on track
Dm **F** **G**
If there's a chance to stir shit up... I'm all over that
Am **Em**
The latest in a series of unfortunate events
Dm **F**
If there's a cure for trouble... well, they ain't found it yet
G
I'm getting my just desserts

CHORUS:

C **Am** **Dm** **G**
And they call me troublemaker... and I don't mind at all
C **Am** **Dm** **G**
I own up: I'm a troublemaker: don't mix with gas or alcohol
Dm **Am**
If you come hang with me tonight, know there might be a fight
C **G**
Won't claim responsibility
Dm **Am**
Come Monday morning I'll be standin' on your porch and givin' you

C **G**
My heartfelt apologies

C **Am**
Yeah, they call me troublemaker
F **G** **Am** (*to Intro*)
And I'll be trouble 'til my dyin' day

VERSE THREE:

Am
I am poison; I am dynamite
Em
'Bout the only thing I did right
Dm **F** **G**
Was givin' you my heart; that's a fact
Am
As usual, I messed it up
Em
The same way that I always done
Dm **F**
Too good at burnin' bridges not to light the match
G (*to Chorus*)
Something's probably gonna get broke

BRIDGE:

E7 **Am**
I always lived my life so that I'd have no regrets
E7
If you'd stop trying to make me change
Am
I know I could have you back
E7
I'm a fool with a careless heart
Am
I guess we'll both just come undone
C **G** (*to Chorus*)
Since you can't take me as I am...
